Meet the workforce of the future

T Levels are a new, two-year qualification for 16 to 19-year-olds. Designed with employers, each T Level is equivalent to 3 A-Levels and helps young people develop the knowledge, attitude and practical skills to thrive in the workplace.

At the heart of each course, is a 45-day industry placement which will give employers early access to the brightest talent entering your industry.

Our students will be placed one or two days per week with an employer from October 2022, working unpaid within the organisation during their studies. We will support you at each stage of your industry placement journey - from selecting the right student through to managing their contribution to your business, and maybe even hiring a new employee.

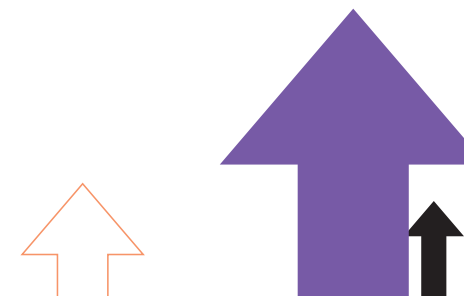
